CONTEMPORARY ART DEALERS OF DALLAS SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

PURPOSE: The Contemporary Art Dealers of Dallas Scholarships assists Booker T. Washington High School for the Performing and Visual Arts graduating students in the Visual Arts Cluster with costs associated with attendance at higher education programs.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP: The \$2,500 CADD Scholarship will be awarded to a Booker T. Washington graduating student pursuing a Fine Arts degree at an accredited university or art institute. The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, equipment, travel, and/or supplies assisting the student in their academic endeavors.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: The Contemporary Art Dealers of Dallas Scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding and deserving Arts Magnet graduating student pursuing study in 2D or 3D art. Qualified candidates will possess a GPA of 80 or above, a complete application (an application that is incomplete will not be considered), a recommendation from a cluster teacher and an academic teacher, as well as submit a portfolio of at least 20 images of artwork, and provide a written response to a question about career goals, personal goals, and reason for applying for the Contemporary Art Dealers of Dallas Scholarship.

SELECTION AND AWARD PROCESS:

- Applications will be given to the Visual Arts Cluster chair and Counselors.
- The Enrichment Committee of The Advisory Board will select the recipient.
- One scholarship will be awarded each school year.
- The recipient will be required to send a thank you note and statement of how funds are to be used to both The Advisory Board and the Contemporary Art Dealers of Dallas Scholarship fund.
