ENRICHMENT GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

THE HUT FUND

GUIDELINES

Purpose: The H.U.T. Fund was established by Pizza Hut in 2008 to assist economically disadvantaged students with finances needed to enrich the students' learning experience and to support their artistic and academic development.

ABOUT H.U.T.: The grants may be used for any financial need that may improve the educational and academic performance of the student. H.U.T. grants per student are not to exceed \$4,000/ academic year. Only two grants may be awarded to the same student per semester-Multiple, unrelated requests may not be combined on a single application. Grants may not be used for college tuition.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Applicants must demonstrate financial need, provide one recommendation from a cluster or academic faculty member that can speak to the specifics of the request, provide a detailed budget on the HUT FUND budget form and write a personal statement that describes the specific use of funds requested and depicts the way in which the grant will enhance their learning experience. Other material in support of your application will be considered.

SELECTION AND AWARD PROCESS:

- Call the Advisory Board office (214/468-8642) with questions or for more information or seek help in the library on Thursdays during lunch.
- Applications for request of \$500 or less will be considered on the 1st and the 15th of each month.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Funds will be available immediately upon approval of the grant and distributed according to the timetable included with the application.
- The recipient will be required to document all grant expenditures on the Budget and Expense forms provided, send a thank you note and provide a report to both The Advisory Board and a H.U.T. representative on benefits received.
